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SCUBA Course Descriptions

Open Water SCUBA Diver

This entry-level course meets the requirements for ISO Level 2- autonomous diver certification. It teaches divers the fundamental knowledge and skills to scuba dive and engage in open water diving activities without supervision.

Duration: 40 hours

Cost: \$600 per student

Advanced Open Water SCUBA Diver

This continuing education course for certified divers is a program designed to introduce and aid divers in gaining experience in a variety of open-water diving activities. Participants will complete six dives; three must be in night/limited visibility, navigation, and deep (beyond 18msw/60fsw within recreational limits). Graduates of this course are considered competent to engage in open water diving activities without supervision.

Duration: 40 hours

Rescue SCUBA Diver

This continuing education course trains divers in the knowledge and skills needed to manage risks and effectively handle limited in-water problems and diving emergencies. The course will include the following: assists, transports, surface rescues and rescues from depth involving both boat- and shore-based skin and scuba divers. The course meets the prerequisite rescue training for NAUI Skin Diving Instructor, NAUI Assistant Instructor, NAUI Divemaster and NAUI Instructor certifications.

Duration: 24 hours

Master SCUBA Diver

This continuing education course is for certified divers who wish to increase their understanding and enjoyment of diving. The course is a progression toward NAUI Leadership roles, and some subject areas are a review and expansion of materials from previous courses

Divemaster

The NAUI Divemaster rating is the highest NAUI leadership level certification except for instructor. The program is designed to train experienced and knowledgeable divers to organize and conduct enjoyable open water dives for certified divers. If all other prerequisites are met, a current NAUI Divemaster is qualified to enter a NAUI Instructor Training Course (ITC).

Duration: 80 hours

Specialty Course Descriptions

Deep Diver

This specialty course provides the diver with the knowledge and skills to plan and conduct dives while minimizing risks. Deep dives are between 18 and 40 m (60 and 130 ft.) and do not require any decompression stops. Graduates are considered competent to engage in open water diving activities without supervision.

Duration: 24 hours

Drysuit Diver

This continuing education course provides the use of dry suits and how to become familiar and comfortable with their thermal protection options, controls, and buoyancy characteristics. Graduates are considered competent to engage in open water diving activities, while using a drysuit, without supervision.

Duration: 24 hours

Night & Limited Visibility Diver

This specialty course for open water scuba certified divers or skin diver certified divers. It provides the diver with the skills and knowledge needed to minimize the risks of diving at night. Upon successful completion of this course, graduates are considered competent to engage in open water diving activities without supervision.

Duration: 24 hours

Search & Recovery Diver

This specialty course is to provide divers with the skills and knowledge to do those underwater tasks commonly needed by the experienced recreational diver and to minimize the risks of such tasks while searching for and recovering items that have been lost in the aquatic environment. Graduates are considered competent to engage in open water diving activities without supervision.

Duration: 40 hours

Specialty Course Descriptions Cont.

Training Assistant

This specialty course is to train divers to assist others during training activities overseen by an active-status NAUI Instructor. This course is to enhance the diver's general skills and abilities and is not a substitute for specific NAUI courses which create NAUI leadership members. Certified training assistants are qualified to perform the tasks of temporarily directly supervising remaining students while an instructor conducts a skill with other students.

Duration: 32 hours

Underwater Post Blast Diver

This course prepares Public Safety Divers for unique duties associated with searching for and identifying evidence after a detonation, either over or under water. The training is intended to provide enhanced diving capability for established public safety dive teams for evidence recovery of waterborne improvised explosive devices.

Waterborne Improvised Explosive Device (UBIED) Search Diver

This course prepares Public Safety Divers for unique duties associated with searching for and identifying waterborne improvised explosive devices. The training is intended to provide enhanced diving capability for established public safety dive teams for immediate response to the threat of waterborne improvised explosive devices.

Duration: 40 hours

Certified Bomb Technicians Only

Waterborne IED Mitigation Course – Phase 1 (Above the Water Line)

This course provides the Public Safety Bomb Technician operating in/near a maritime port or waterway a period of classroom instruction and multiple practical exercises that will train the PSBT on mitigating a threatened, suspected, or actual waterborne IED's. This will include aboard boats or ships, on or near maritime infrastructure, and in water that will be accessible from shore, pier, or boat.

The PSBT will get instruction on tactics and potential targets in the maritime community, bomb squad equipment and procedures while operating in a maritime community, boarding procedures, water survival/self-rescue, blast considerations to include the radiological threats on board a vessel, blast effects of an underwater explosion, commercial vessel familiarization to include cargo space overview, and on board lock out/tag out procedures.

Specialty Course Descriptions Cont.

Waterborne IED Mitigation Course – Phase 2 (Below the Water Line)

This course provides the Public Safety Bomb Technician operating in/near a maritime port or waterway a period of classroom instruction and multiple practical exercises that will train the PSBT on mitigating an underwater IED problem.

This course will continue the training provided in Phase 1 for bomb squad procedures operating in a maritime environment to include remote cut and pull procedures while underwater, current underwater render safe procedures to include the use of short barreled disruptors specific to the maritime community, underwater explosions, under the hull search techniques, limpet and other underwater ordnances identification encountered in the maritime community, and common underwater IED's utilized.

This course will require the PSBT to be a proficient diver and be able to provide the necessary documentation and/or hours to complete the course.
